This is in response to your letter of June 27, 2013, wherein you submitted the revised chemical composition of the above-mentioned product.

Based on the information submitted, we can advise that we see no reason to object to the composition and use of this product as a **lubricant with incidental food contact** in food plants provided that:

- a) it is used on equipment or machine parts where contact of the lubricant with food is **only** incidental;
- b) it is used in the minimum amount required to achieve its intended technical effect; and
- should the product be used as an anti-rust film on the equipment, it must be effectively removed from the surfaces by washing or wiping prior to re-use of the equipment.

In regards to the label, we suggest that the claim "Non-Toxic/Non-hazardous" be removed from the label as it might be misleading at the user level.
